

**Memorandum of Understanding
Between YCCD and the Yosemite Faculty Association**

The purpose of this memorandum of understanding is to outline the agreement between YFA and college administration regarding the workload for **unique courses in the Arts, Humanities, and Communications Division**:

Art Studio Courses

The 15 equated load established in the Tentative Agreement (2017-2020) created a load of 34% for faculty. The new load of 34% prevents adjunct instructors from teaching (4) studio sections total during Fall and Spring. Therefore, this agreement moves that load from 34% to 33.5 % (reducing the 80% lab load to 78.33%), as was the past practice, to allow adjunct instructors to teach two classes per term, effective Fall 2019.
